



PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA – INFORMATION UNDER THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (2016/679/EG)

Magnus Wittbom Advokatbyrå AB is the personal data controller with regard to the personal data which we process in connection with assignments or which we otherwise process when client assignments are prepared or administered. You are under no obligation to provide us with your personal data, but if you refrain from doing so we cannot provide you with legal services, as we cannot carry out the required conflict and anti-money laundering checks..

We process personal data in order to carry out mandatory conflict checks and (where applicable) anti-money laundering checks, to perform and manage client assignments, to safeguard your interests as well as for accounting and billing purposes. Such data is processed in order for the law firm to fulfil its agreement with you, as well as to fulfil its legal obligations.

We will not disclose personal data to third parties other than when (i) it has been agreed upon between you and the law firm, (ii) it is necessary within the scope of a given assignment in order to safeguard your rights, (iii) it is necessary in order for us to fulfil a legal obligation, or to comply with a decision of a public authority or of a court of law; or (iv) if we engage an external service provider who performs services on our behalf. If necessary to safeguard your rights, the data may be transferred to courts, public authorities, counterparties and their counsel.

In accordance with the law firm's obligation under the Code of Conduct of the Swedish Bar Association, personal data is saved for a period of ten years from the date when the assignment is concluded, or for a longer period if required given the nature of the assignment.

You have the right to request information free of charge regarding your personal data which the law firm processes. We will correct or delete data that is incorrect or restrict the processing of such data, at your request or on our own initiative. Further, you have the right to request that your data is not processed for direct marketing purposes. In addition, you have the right to receive your personal data in a machine-readable format or, if technically possible, to instruct us to transfer the data to a third party. If you are dissatisfied with our processing of personal data, you can file a complaint with the supervisory authority, which in Sweden is Datainspektionen (www.datainspektionen.se). You can also contact the supervisory authority of the country in which you live or work.
